- Investment in Dr. Anthony Albers Nusculaskeletal Research Project for the advencement of surgical programs and the building of a valuable data base surrounding knee and hip replacements.
- Ongoing support for our state-of-the-act Orthopaedic Robotics program enabling St. Mary's to perform the largest number of hip and knee replacements in the province annually.
- Creating the 24-hour Newtorn Weight Loss Calculation to promote breastfeeding and measure the impact on in-hospital formula supplement
- Reducing west times for psychotherapy care with the launch of the Biving gesources and Support to our patients (GRASP) project to offer group therapy sessions which improve access to vital care and also reduce social
- Support for Dr. Rosans Faria for the Looking Forward Program which is a practical guide and resource tool to help recovering cancer patients rebuild their lives after treatment.
- Funding Dr. Julia Chabet of the Division of Genatric Medicine at St. Mary's Hispital Center for her project of musical Interventions for sleep facilitation in Scute Genstric Settings.
- Listriching inacqual fellowship to welcome fellow from larsel to pertocpate in vital research with Dr. Maryae Larouche for streamlining the diagnosis and treatment of debilitating pelvic floor dysfunctions which affects almost one quarter of adult women.
- One quarter or usual waveful and are process for cancer patients and implementation of a state-of-the-art process for cancer patients and their caregivers, which ecreens symptoms using a mobile app, improving the understanding of how patients and caregivers cope and adjust.
- Anarding ennual bursaries for our valuable nurses, honouring our commoment to providing enhanced skills and braining.

- Upgrading our facilities with improvements to the ICU Family Room and staff lounges on the 5<sup>th</sup> Floor, Physiotherapy and Surgery departments.






